To ensure the transition between primary school and high school is an enjoyable experience, we have planned several events during Term 4, 2022 to allow your child/ward to familiarise themselves with all things high school.

Picnic Day details as follows:

Time: 9.30am to 2.30pm.

Cost: \$5.00.

Transport: Students are to meet at Sacred Heart Primary School (SHPS) and will walk to and from Broken Hill High School with SHPS staff.

Requirements: Students should bring water, a hat and wear sunscreen. It is suggested that a sports uniform be worn.

Information: Year 7 students at Broken Hill High School each year take part in our Peer Support Program. The Peer Support Program creates a buddy system between your child/ward and their peer support leaders to ensure they are supported in their transition to high school. The Picnic Day provides the opportunity for your child/ward to meet their peer leaders for 2023 and partake in several peer activities. Recess of chips and fruit along with a sausage sizzle lunch will be provided.

When: Tuesday, 29 November 2022.

Where: Broken Hill High School

Time: 9.30am to 2.30pm.

Transport: Students are to meet at Sacred Heart Primary School (SHPS) and will walk to and from Broken Hill High School with SHPS staff.

Requirements: Students will need to bring their own recess and lunch or can purchase from the Canteen.
