<b>Description:</b>	<p>During Term 1 2025, Year 10 students will be participating in Sport as per the details below. There will be no cost involved.</p> <p>Off school grounds permission notes need to be completed online prior to leaving school grounds. These were emailed out at the beginning of Term 1. If the permission note is not completed, your child/ward will remain at school.</p>
<b>Venue:</b>	R K Sanderson Basketball Stadium (Boughtman Street, Broken Hill)
<b>Start Location:</b>	Students will attend regular lessons until the time indicated on the permission note, when they will meet to travel to the venue.
<b>End Location:</b>	Students will return to Broken Hill High School and attend their regular classes.
<b>Transport:</b>	Students will travel to and from the venue via chartered bus.
<b>Dress Code:</b>	Full sport uniform.
<b>Additional Information:</b>	<p>If your child/ward is unable to participate due to sickness or injury, a note is to be handed to Miss Gillespie ASAP before sport, alternate arrangements will be made for your child/ward.</p> <p>All students are expected to have their full sport uniform and suitable footwear (sneakers that lace up). If your child/ward does not have a change of clothes or appropriate footwear, please provide a note so that they can participate in sport. If your child/ward is out of uniform, they may be placed on detention with the teacher of that sport group.</p> <p>Students are encouraged to Slip, Slop, Slap, Slide, Seek and bring a water</p>

bottle.

### Important information

Personal injury statement In the event of injury, no personal injury insurance cover is provided by the NSW Department of Education for students in relation to school sporting activities, physical education lessons or any other school activity. The Department's public liability cover is fault-based and limited to breaches by the Department of its duty of care to students that may result in claims for compensation.

Parents/Carers are advised to assess the level and extent of their child/ward's involvement in the sport program offered by the school, school sport zone, region and state school sport associations when deciding whether additional insurance cover is required prior to their child's involvement in the program.

Personal accident insurance cover is available through normal retail outlets. Parents/Carers who have private ambulance cover need to check whether that cover extends to interstate travel and make additional arrangements as considered appropriate. The NSW Supplementary Sporting Injury Benefits Scheme, funded by the NSW Government, provides limited cover for serious injury resulting in the permanent loss of a prescribed faculty or the loss of use of certain prescribed parts of the body. ### Concussion Clearance and Medical Treatment

The Australian Medical Association recommends students being symptom free of concussion for 14 days before returning to sport.

- I acknowledge that if my child has sustained a concussion in the lead up to the event, I must provide medical clearance to the school or the supervising teacher prior to competition commencing.
- I understand that if my child sustains a concussion or suspected concussion during an NSW Department of Education sporting event, they will be removed from competition until medical clearance is provided to the supervising teacher
- I affirm that, to the best of my knowledge, my child has no medical condition or injury that places them at risk by participating in this sport activity. I acknowledge The NSW Ambulance Schools and Group Cover Scheme 2024 (ASGCS) is an insurance policy that provides coverage for emergency ambulance services to NSW public school students attending approved, fully supervised school activities within NSW.
