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COVID-19 Sign in Policies and Procedures

All parents/carers and accompanying children attending the Teddy Bear's Picnic on Tuesday, 31 August 2021 will be required to sign in through the Front Office to ensure all COVID-19 policies and procedures are followed. It is also expected that groups remain 1.5m apart when circulating around the stalls/activities to prevent any close contact.

During stalls/activities:

- **Hand sanitiser** will be available throughout all areas of the school and at each stall/activity organised throughout the event.
- All equipment to be used must be **cleaned prior to** visitors using them **and at the end** of the event.
- **Regular hand washing breaks.**
- **Regularly wash/wipe down equipment** (for example, when visitors are having a break to wash their hands, drink or eat).
- **No** large groups of more than 10.

After Stalls/Activities:

- All students and associated classroom teachers will be required to clean/wipe down used equipment and pack away once thoroughly cleaned.
- Visitors will need to exit through the Front Office again and sign out upon exit.
