### **Reason for Absence Notes**

### It is a legal requirement that if a child is absent for any reason then it must be explained in a signed note by the parent/caregiver.

The Home School Liaison Officer checks for notes to match absences and if absences are not accompanied by a note parents/caregivers may need to explain.

Certain procedures must be carried out when children are absent from school for **any** period of time including full day absence and partial absence (late arrival to school/early departure due to appointments or sickness etc.).

The school has provided a 'REASON FOR ABSENCE' note to assist you to notify the school when your child is absent or late. More notes are available from the Front Office if required.
